ORDINANCE CERTIFYING ADVANCE OF FUNDS
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of South Russell, Geauga County, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The sum of \$ 160,000 is hereby certified to be **advanced**:


FROM: Income Tax Fund TO: Manor Brook Fund \$ 160,000

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare and safety of the residents of the Village of South Russell and for the further reason that the funds are needed immediately to meet the budgetary obligations of the Village.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees on or after December 2, 1975, that resulted in formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22, Ohio Revised Code.
