FROM THE MAYOR

The recognition luncheon for Village military veterans will be held Monday, November 14, 2022, at 11:30 a.m. at the Sleepy Rooster. The guest speaker will be Vietnam veteran Dave Lange, former editor of the Chagrin Valley Times. The South Russell Village Park Master Plan is being studied to determine if and how the Village implements the recommendations presented. Walking tours with the Foundation for Geauga Parks, the Geauga County Park District, the Western Reserve Land Conservancy, and the Chagrin River Watershed Partners have resulted in positive ideas on how to manage the park. The Village continues to plan for a burn of a portion of the park, probably in 2024. The Master Plan can be found on the Parks page of southrussell.com.

The latest storm water projects are underway south of Village Hall and at the intersection of Manor Brook Dr. and Chillicothe Rd. Both projects will capture, hold, and slowly release water to reduce damage to private property.

Back to School



With schools back in session, please be observant of the School Zone Speed Limit. When flashing, the speed limit is **20 mph**. Likewise, note that it is **ILLEGAL** to go around a stopped school bus. Please keep our children safe by adhering to these laws!

Geauga County Erosion Special Improvement District Program

The Geauga County Auditor's Office has created an Erosion Special Improvement District (ESID) to help residents creatively finance their often-expensive erosion control projects. Such projects include dredging and repair of privately owned lakes as well as a variety of stormwater-related issues. Involvement in an ESID is voluntary and may be a single resident or groups of residents. The property owners who elect to engage the ESID are obligated to repay the project costs via a special assessment placed on their tax duplicate by the County Auditor. The amortization period is typically between 15 and 20 years. What is unique about an ESID is that property owner(s) can sell their property with the assessment in place and the obligation would then be assumed by the new owner. Although the projects are subject to local and State permitting, the residents are responsible for engaging the contractors and engineers, thus alleviating the mandated expenses associated with a municipal project. This represents a significant cost savings to residents. SEPTIC SYSTEM REMINDER



As of January 1, 2021, the inspection and cleaning requirement for septic systems installed in the Village of South Russell after September 23,

NOPEC and Rising Electricity Rates

NOPEC is advising residents in participating communities like South Russell to consider switching from NOPEC to the default Illuminating Company provider, FirstEnergy, for electricity. FirstEnergy's kilowatt per hour rate until September 30th, will be 6.832 KwH and 6.714 from October 1 – May 2023. NOPEC's currently ranges between 8.9 and 12 KwH. This is due to the timing of locking in supplier rates by both companies. NOPEC will have the opportunity to renegotiate with the next energy auction in January 2023. To switch suppliers, call NOPEC at 855-667-3201 and select the electric service option.

Friendly Reminder: Lock Your Doors!

Recently, local communities have seen an increase in preventable thefts. South Russell Police Department is asking our residents to help reduce crimes of opportunity. Many people around the country have started to embrace the "9pm Routine" before going to bed to shore up security for the night. These safety checks include: (1) Removing any valuables from cars, (2) Locking all vehicle doors, (3) Locking all exterior doors to your home, and (4) Turning on an exterior

light. We would like to add a 5th! Never, ever leave your car keys in the vehicle overnight.

South Russell is a safe place to call home for our residents. Together, we can send a strong message to any would-be criminals that South Russell is NOT a place for easy crimes of opportunity. Let's lock it up!



History Around South Russell

This 182-year-old home still stands at 5277 Chillicothe Rd. and is a reminder of the determination of the old pioneers. Built in 1840, Alexander McLaughlin (1830-1881) bought the home in 1864, and on his death, it was passed to his son, Ozell McLaughlin (1858-1940). Ozell's daughters were Lillie (1891-1970), Laura Bezdek (1894-1987), and Ruth Hawkins (b. 1901). Laura built a home across the street from Ozell's home. Ruth's daughter, Shirel Pitz, built the home just north of Ozell's, and Ozell's great grandson, Dave Pitz, built the home just north of Shirel's. This was a natural progression in farm families, with five generations living in the same location.

Shirel Pitz and her children sold corn and pumpkins from the property for years in the 1960's and 70's. Members of the McLaughlin family are buried in Rarick Cemetery on Bell Rd.

The home now serves as offices for The Lantern of Chagrin. Preservation of the home and barn were a priority to both the Village and developer in conjunction with the transition of the property to a business.
