Porter introduced an ordinance transferring \$20,000 from the Income Tax fund to the Culvert Fund and declaring an emergency. Porter made a motion to waive readings, seconded by Bell. Roll call – ayes, all. Motion carried. Porter made a motion to adopt, seconded by Bell. Motion carried. **ORD 2022-112**

Galicki made a motion to approve a Purchase Order for CT Consultants in the amount of \$20,000 for culvert project engineering and \$70,000 for the Central Retention Basin project, seconded by Cavanagh. Voice vote – ayes, all. Motion carried.

Porter made a motion to appoint a representative to the Geauga County ESID Board. Porter suggested it be either the Chair of Public Utilities or his or her designee, seconded by Cavanagh. Voice vote -ayes, all. Motion carried.
