Please note this is the only trash day in 2015. A fall trash day will not be scheduled.

Residency identification may be required.

ITEMS THAT WILL BE ACCEPTED INCLUDE:

General trash/debris, scrap & white metal such as appliances, electronic & computer equipment, items containing freon (refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, air conditioners) and tires.

SENIOR TRASH PICKUP

The South Russell Village Officials are joining forces with the Geauga County Department on Aging for the senior trash pickup:

Seniors, 60 years of age or older, living in South Russell Village and wishing to have a pickup scheduled on Senior Trash Collection Day must be registered by calling the Geauga County Department on Aging between the hours of 8:00 am – 4:30 pm at 440-279-2130, or 440-564-7131 at extension 2130 or 440-834-1856 at extension 2130. You will be asked your name, address, phone number, date of birth and the items needing picked up. This spring pickup is on a first-come, first serve basis and the number of senior residents that can be served is limited.

Some items such as hazardous household chemicals, liquefied products and paint products that will not be accepted during the Village Spring Trash Day will be collected this year at a one-day Geauga County collection event, hosted by the Geauga-Trumbull Solid Waste Management District. The Village of South Russell Implements a Curfew

South Russell Village Council passed an ordinance establishing a curfew for minors. This new ordinance is very similar to the 1997 ordinance passed in the neighboring community of Chagrin Falls. The particular times and age ranges specified in the ordinance mirror one another to avoid confusion between communities. A curfew is in place for:

- 1. A child under the age of sixteen between 11:00 p.m. & 6:00 a.m.
- 2. A child age sixteen or seventeen, between 1:00 a.m. & 6:00 a.m.

South Russell Village Cemetery

The construction of the South Russell Village Cemetery is almost complete. This cemetery is a beautiful final resting place for current and past residents of South Russell Village. Pricing for full size cemetery lots are \$1,000 for South Russell residents and \$2,000 for former South Russell residents. Pricing for cremation cemetery lots are \$800 for South Russell residents and \$1,600 for former South Russell residents. Opening and closing cost are as follows:

Cremation \$ 350 Weekday

\$ 450 Saturday

NEW PARK LEASH REQUIREMENTS

As of April 14, 2015, all animals at the park will be required to be on a leash in **all areas** of the park **EVERYDAY**. The leash must be no longer than 8 feet in length and the animal must be controlled. In addition, animal owners are responsible for cleaning up the animal waste. Violators of these requirements can receive a fine of up to \$500.

Park Pavilion Permit

To reserve the pavilion at the South Russell Village Park, you will need to submit a Park Pavilion Permit with a \$25 nonrefundable fee. South Russell ~ Show Your Colors

Between 300 to 350 flags are displayed three times each year in the Village of South Russell. The first display is early summer when flags are flown for Memorial Day through the Independence Day holiday. Flags are again put up the last week in August for the Labor Day holiday and September 11th. The flags are displayed for the final time in late fall for the November Election Day and Veterans Day on November 11th. Extreme weather conditions from heat, wind, cold, rain and snow can take a toll on the flags, poles and hardware, which are purchased through private donations. WHY?

- 1) The Village often receives calls from people considering moving to the area, but they want to know specific homeowner association (HOA) rules for a neighborhood. If we don't have current contact information, we can't help.
- 2) When situations such as power outages, flooding, or road programs occur, it would be beneficial to contact the HOA president and have them forward information to the residents of the neighborhood. This would spread the word faster.

What to do if you lose electrical power:

Don't assume the Illuminating Company knows about it—Report it!

Check your neighbors to see if their power is out or if only your house is effected. If only your power is out, check your circuit breaker or fuses. If no breaker is tripped or fuses are blown, the problem may be in the connection between the wires and your home. Call the Illuminating Company's toll-free, 24 hour Outage Reporting line at 1-888-LIGHTSS (1-888-544-4877).

If your neighbors' lights are out too, call 1-888-LIGHTSS (1-888-544-4877) immediately. The Illuminating Company may not know that your power is out unless you notify them and often times, your neighbors assume someone else has called about the outage. Also, if more people call to report an outage, it helps The Illuminating Company prioritize where to send repair crews so it is very important to actually report the outage as soon as possible. Follow the recorded prompts to let them know your power is out. The Illuminating Company will then try to fix your connection as soon as possible.

Voter Registration

The deadline for registering to vote in the November 3, 2015 general election is October 5, 2015. You can register to vote, or change your address if you have moved at any public library, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, at the Board of Elections, or by mail. The polls will be open on November 3, 2015 from 6:30AM to 7:30PM.

Preventing Crimes of Opportunity

One of the easiest crimes to prevent -- burglary -- is also one of the most common. Somewhere in the U.S. there's a burglary committed every 15 seconds. If it happens at your home, you lose more than a few possessions. A break-in, even when you're not there, has a major impact on you and your family's sense of safety and well-being.

The first thing a burglar looks for when choosing a house for a break-in is one with no one in it. If you make your house look occupied when you're gone, most burglars will simply pass it by. Never leave doors or windows unlocked, and ALWAYS close overhead garage doors, especially at night.

Theft from an unlocked vehicle is also a common crime of opportunity. The most effective way to prevent this type of crime is to limit the criminal's ability and/or opportunity to commit the crime. Below are a few suggestions to keep you from becoming a victim:

- Keep your vehicle locked at all times Even in your own driveway or garage
- Do not leave valuables in plain view
- Keep all valuables in the trunk or take them with you
- Do not leave any cell phone chargers, cables, or electronic devices in plain sight. It may give the impression that you have electronics somewhere inside the vehicle
- Once home, unload your valuables immediately and do not store them inside your vehicle
- Close your garage door
