ORDINANCE APPROVING THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH RUSSELL TO APPLY FOR FUNDS TO THE OHIO SENATE CAPITAL BUDGET AND ONE-TIME STRATEGIC COMMUNITY INVESTMENT FUND TO INSTALL A RESTROOM FACILITY AT THE VILLAGE PARK, AUTHORIZING THE STREET COMMISSIONER AND VILLAGE ENGINEER TO EXECUTE AND/OR SUBMIT THE APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Senate, through its capital Budget and One-Time Strategic Community Investment Fund program ("OTSCIF"), provides an application process through which it awards money for certain community and infrastructure projects; and

WHEREAS, Village of South Russell desires to seek, through the application process, such OTSCIF funds to install a restroom facility to be located at the Village Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of South Russell, Geauga County, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The Ohio Senate Capital Budget/OTSCIF Application 2024 for the installation of a restroom facility at the Village Park, as prepared by the Village and attached hereto as <u>Attachment 1</u>, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The Street Commissioner and the Village Engineer are hereby authorized to execute and/or submit to the Ohio Senate the Ohio Senate Capital Budget/OTSCIF Application 2024 for the installation of a restroom facility at the Village Park, attached hereto as **Attachment 1**, on behalf of the Village.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees on or after December 2, 1975, that resulted in formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22, Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason to ensure that the application is submitted timely; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage by this Council and approval by the Mayor.
