Regularly scheduled, sunshined Properties Committee met on 12/12/24, called to order at 1:07pm. Present were Councilmen Canton and Cavanagh, Mayor Koons, Streets Young.

Discussion about Masons flagpole light--inadequate. Young states will find a solution, may need electrifying. Koons mentioned that Eagle Kiosk at South Park also needs attention.

Holiday lights are in place, some have been on back order.

Young discussed garage doors. Looking at 3" doors, with high windows.

Koons will contact Cleveland Hiking Club, some others, to lead Spring walk to inform about Burn. Koons heard from a Southwyck resident that she no longer walks the Park due to presence of bugs, ticks.

Discussion of possibilities with SE corner lot. The S Russell sign could be placed there. Various ideas put forward: pavilion? clock? fencing? TBD.

Mayor suggested setting firm date earlier for Fall Festival. Other changes can include food trucks, noticeable T-shirts for helpers.

Pavilion Ceiling discussed. Young and men will try to brace. Builder is not interested in job.

Decision to paint interior Village Hall over winter.

Semiguincentennial plans go forward. Need a Village resident to join Committee.
