Streets meeting called to order at 2:30 on February 24, 2025. Present were Tim Young, Bill Koons, Dennis Galicki & Ruth Cavanagh.

Discussion regarding the 2020 truck, which Streets Young states was upfitted & re-upfitted. Now has water in the hydraulic system, although it only has 512 hours of use. It is dumping 3X amount of salt as needed. Streets Young states the pump is forecast to fail at 1200 hours. Do we pay to re-upfit again? Galicki asked, Is it in the budget to replace? To repair? Estimates are needed.

Streets Young asked again for a PT Employee, Dept. was down to 2 during last plowing marathon. One on scheduled, paid vacation; one injured and needs surgery (3/7/25). Discussion followed. Galicki asked, could we start with a call-in CDL driver to help with plowing? Young replied not likely, based on fact that most surrounding Depts. are also searching for FT workers, yet needs are 9not being met. Mayor stated agrees with PT worker. Needs to be discussed with HR co-meeting in very near future.

Streets Young discussed current work being completed, including cold patching of rough Bell Rd. East, and other potholes. Dormant overhanging trees are being pruned back.

Discussion regarding upcoming Trash Days. Saturday, April 26, but Senior pickup begins Wednesday, April 23. There are worker time conflicts, Cavanagh to reach out to Bainbridge, Streets Young to ask Russell for worker assistance. TBD.

Bellwood HOA requested new street signs, Discussion, Young to follow up.

Cavanagh expressed great disappointment at learning Bell Rd. East not to be paved until 2026, per Mayor, NOACA and ODOT. Patching will continue.
