A sunshined, scheduled Park meeting convened at the south Park flagpole at 6:30pm on 4/13/26. Attendees: Cavanagh, Ted Kruse, Greg Gamm, Martha Bistriz and Patrick Gibney, who asked Park Cmte. for permission to proceed with his proposed Eagle project. Patrick noted that he attempted to go forward last Fall, but early snow interfered.

Gibney showed his drawings, plans, sketches. The committee wanted short 4 paths reduced to no more than 3. They were flexible, as long as at least 1 path exists, to access the flag.

Bistriz reminded that less maintenance for the Service Dept. is a goal.

Cavanagh stated there needs to be some color at this end of the Park.

Gamm would like to incorporate mostly native plants.

Kruse stated preference to use a couple lower bushes. He'd also like some sunflowers.

Gibney described his work group of Scouts, willing to help. There are logistics of ordering and buying plants, as well as working around Scouts who already have jobs.

Next step is to have plan ok'd by SRV Council.
