ORDINANCE APPROVING WORK ORDER #1 TO THE MASTER SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL CONSULTING SERVICES WITH VERDANTAS FOR WORK FOR THE HAZELWOOD STORM SEWER AND PAVEMENT REPLACEMENT PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$181,000.00, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE WORK ORDER #1 ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has entered into a Master Services Agreement with Verdantas for professional consulting services, including engineering services;

WHEREAS, Council tasked Verdantas with surveying, existing pipe video documentation, design, bidding, and project management and inspection work on behalf of the Village in connection with the Hazelwood Storm Sewer and Pavement Replacement Project (the "Project");

WHEREAS, Verdantas has provided Council with Work Order #1 to the Master Services Agreement for the scope of services for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to approve Work Order #1 to the Master Services Agreement to allow Verdantas to perform the scope of services for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of South Russell, Geauga County, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. Work Order #1 to the Master Services Agreement, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as **Exhibit 1**, describing the scope of services work to be performed by Verdantas for the Project is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$181,000.00.

SECTION 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Work Order #1 to the Master Services Agreement on behalf of the Village.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees on or after December 2, 1975, that resulted in formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22, Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason to enable Verdantas to begin the scope of services for the Project; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of all

members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by this Council.

Hazelwood Storm Sewer and Pavement Replacement

Work Order #1 to Master Service Agreement for Consulting Services

Mr. Koons:

Verdantas LLC (Verdantas) is pleased to provide this Work Order Request under the Master Service Agreement for Consulting Services between Verdantas and the Village of South Russell. The subsequent sections of this letter describe our current project understanding, and proposed scope of services for this Work Order.

Project Understanding

Verdantas understands that the Project is located primarily on Hazelwood Drive.

Scope of Services

Task 1 – Survey \$17,000

Collect site survey information for design of a storm sewer.

Task 2 – Existing Pipe Video Documentation \$10,000

Conduct internal pipe videography to better understand the existing storm sewer configuration and aid in design.

Task 3 – Design \$74,000

Develop a plan set for a new storm sewer to replace the existing system, allowing capacity for future intersecting streets south of Hazelwood.

Task 4 – Bidding \$5,000

Preparation of project specifications and bid/contract documents, support for project advertisement, soliciting contractors, bid evaluation, contractor selection and project award.



Task 5 – Project Management and Inspection \$75,000

Provide project management and onsite inspection for an anticipated project duration of 3 months.

Estimated Cost

The estimated cost to complete the tasks described in this Work Order is \$181,000. Verdantas will bill against this budget on a in accordance with terms of the MSA.

Estimated Schedule

The proposed scope of services described herein can be completed by June 19, 2027.


