ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 264.01 OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH RUSSELL'S CODIFIED ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council desires to amend Section 264.01 of the Village of South Russell's Codified Ordinances to allow for the establishment of alternate members to the Architectural Board of Review.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of South Russell, Geauga County, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. Section 264.01 of the Village of South Russell's Codified Ordinances currently provides as follows:

"There is hereby established for the Village an Architectural Board of Review, which shall consist of three members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council. Such appointments shall be for terms of three years, except that the first members appointed shall be appointed for terms expiring one, two and three years from the date of their respective initial appointments. Members of the Board are subject to removal at any time by the Mayor."

SECTION 2. Section 264.01 of the Village of South Russell's Codified Ordinances is hereby deleted and amended to read in full as follows:

"There is hereby established for the Village an Architectural Board of Review, which shall consist of three regular members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council and two alternate members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council. Such appointments shall be for terms of three years, except that the first members appointed shall be appointed for terms expiring one, two and three years from the date of their respective initial appointments. Members of the Board are subject to removal at any time by the Mayor."

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees on or after December 2, 1975, that resulted in formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village and to establish alternate members for the Architectural Board of Review ; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to

Council, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage by this Council.
